A Quiz Competition is being organized for Rotarians, Interactors, Rotaractors and Inner Wheel members. At a zonal level in two stages. District 3140 has been fairly slotted into four zones, details of which will be shared with all separately.

While Central and North Zone will have their competition on 14th/15th October 2009 at their respective venues. South and West Zone will participate on 21st/22nd October 2009. Each team will be made up of two participants and we are not averse to the idea of Rotarian, Interactors, Rotaractors and Inner Wheel members blending to form a team.

Each Club can forward not more than two teams for the competition. Top two teams from each zone will make it to the grand finale which will be held on "**MISSION GREEN EARTH DAY**" which is 1st of November 2009 at the Chembur Fine Arts Society. The format of the quiz which has been particularly designed to ensure a lofty echelon is achieved in the quality of contest, will be made available via separate mail. They are required to submit their artefacts before the below mentioned cut off date to the jury for their review.

Works which are found to be objectionable or out of context will be censured from display. Those pieces of art which are finally cleared by the jury will be put up for display at the Chembur Fine Arts Society on the "MISSION GREEN EARTH DAY".

Last Date for submission of entries is the 20th of October 2009.

Rotaractors, Interactors & Inner Wheel members can forward their entries directly if they are forming independent teams. However, if Rotarians, Rotaractors, Interactors & Inner Wheel members intent to come together to form a team, their entry should be submitted only through the Rotary Club.
