You are requested to initiate suitable action against the Builder and also your staff of 'S' ward for turning a blind eye to this misuse of public land for commercial usage. Also please let me know what amount is being paid by Builder to MCGM for maintaining this 'Open space'. Also, what is the share of MCGM in collections being done by builder from Tennis court which is being run exclusively for Residents of Hiranandani. You are requested to reclaim the Land after getting it restored to its Forest like Fauna from the Builder at the earliest.
