

# Light houses

There are 3 light houses in the Mumbai Harbour and one near Alibaug

**South to North these are:**

## Dolphin Light House

- 1850, Active... 4 flashes every 20seconds
- Accessible only by boat
- The stone tower topped by a circular keeper's house, lantern and gallery.



## Prongs Light House (Colaba Point)

- 1874, Active... White Flashes every 10 seconds
- This historic offshore lighthouse marks the entrance to Mumbai Harbour
- It is one of the few offshore lighthouses in the world still staffed.



## Sunk Rock Light House

- 1884 Active... 2 flashes every 6 seconds
- Swimming races are held between the lighthouse and the Gateway of India, a famous landmark on the Mumbai waterfront
- Tower painted in a red and yellow checkerboard pattern; lantern and gallery painted white



## Kanagi Angre Light House (Khanderi Island, Kennerly Island)

- 1867 Active... 2 flashes every 10 seconds
- octagonal cut stone tower with lantern and gallery, attached to a 1-story keeper's house
- The tower is unpainted; lantern painted white; lantern roof is gray metallic.
