### Why a P. G. Certificate Course in RTI?

The Right to Information Act, implemented throughout the Nation since 12 October, 2005, is empowering citizens to monitor and improve their governance. For the first time the individual citizen has a tool by which he can bring about a truly participative democracy in the Country. There is a widespread need to understand this Act systematically to be able to use it more effectively.

### Objectives of Certificate Course

There are two types of Courses being offered:

1) Foundation Course and 2) Advance Course. Both the Courses will explain the historical and philosophical background of this Right. A systematic analysis of the provisions of the Act would also be taken up, which should enable the participants to clearly understand the limitations and possibilities of this Right. A great deal of stress will be laid on getting the participants to define the objectives when using the Act and to drafting a focused RTI application.

The Foundation Course is designed for people who have had either no exposure to RTI earlier, or have used it casually. The focus will be on explaining how to use the RTI effectively.

The Advance Course is designed for those who have been using the Act with some regularity and are now seeking to improve their understanding and skills. This Course would also analyse some of the orders of the information Commissions and devote some time to understanding the work of the Public Information Officers. This Course aims to equip the participants to draft appeals and some practical understanding of the hearings in appeals.

## Eligibility for Admission to the Course

#### For Foundation Course:

A candidate passing the Bachelor's Degree examination in any faculty/discipline of University of Mumbai or a corresponding degree examination of any other University recognized as equivalent thereto is eligible for admission to this Course.

#### For Advance Course:

Using RTI for over six months. Filling of at least 3 RTI applications and one first appeal; or a law degree; or experience as a Public Information Officer.

#### **Admission Procedure**

- A candidate seeking admission is required to apply in the prescribed form.
- The admission form and brochure will be available at the college office from June 27, 2008 between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm on payment of Rs.100.
- The admission form duly filled in along with the prescribed fee should be submitted at the college office on or before July 26, 2008.

#### Fee for the Course

Every candidate shall pay Rs. 2,000 in cash by way of fees at the time of submitting the form. Fees once paid shall not be refunded for any reason whatsoever.

### Course Strength

The Course will admit only 50 participants at a time on first come first served basis. A minimum of 30 participants must register, for the Course to commence.

#### Commencement of the Course

Foundation Course shall commence on August 2, 2008, every alternate Saturday.

Advanced Course shall commence on August 9, 2008, every alternate Saturday.
