

areas of beach, forests and other green areas continue to be vandalized by the industrialist, bureaucrat and politician beyond the scope of approved Regional Plan.


The dredging of Rewas Port and illegal land reclamation in the area will increase the haphazard tidal movement causing irreparable damages to fragile eco-system destroying fishing habitats, devouring the beautiful beaches of Alibag in the name of globalization.

Natural water courses are being altered and would lead to water logging of low lying areas and will cause seepage of brackish water onto Farm lands destroying the famous supari, mango and coconut baug/orchards as well as reduce yields of agricultural produce. Untold misery is being purposefully brought upon by those seeking fame and money for their selfish use.

## ❖ COLLECTOR AND FOREST OFFICE LAXITY AND OTHER INTERESTS

NOW the fertile agriculture plots and those near the sea have been taken over and purchased by the industrialist and political heavy weights through fraud and deceit. It is the law of the land that an agriculture plot can be purchased by only an Agriculturist/Farmer.





The BHOODAN Movement by Acharya Vinobha Bhave and the coveted Haijan, common man and farmer as voiced by the Mahatma Gandhi have been lost upon the present day political dons.

But authorities and land brokers have produced fabricated documents and the law circumvented to blindly accepted these fraudulent documents under the folds of laundered money. The verdant taluka of ALIBAG, the eco-sensitive and tourist destination has borne the brunt of wanton tree felling and illegal conversion of agriculture and diversion of virgin forest land into non-conforming uses for the past 30 years.

The Office of the Collector and the Town Planning Authority have allowed construction of hotels and bungalows of the high and mighty along coastal stretches in violation of Coastal Regulation Zone regulations and Environment Protection Act prescribed by Central Government.

The Villages of Alibag from Mandva, to Kihim on the North and up to Murud have been vandalised by these so called land investors and neo-rich encroaching on beach, intruding into the sea by illegal reclamation and devouring forests through ingenious means and ways, and in utter disregard to Bombay Tenancy and Agricultural Lands Act, Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, Forests Act and Maharashtra Regional and Town Planning Act.

- THE QUESTIONS AND WHO WILL ANSWER THEM The discerning questions remain to be answered:
  - 1. Is it verified from the revenue records as to how these entities have purchased and got the agriculture land transferred into their name without following due process of law?



- 2. Is it verified from the revenue records whether these entities are holding land in excess of land holding limitation as set out under the law?
- 3. Is it verified from the actual survey as to the change of use of such transferred agricultural land to other non-confirming uses?
- 4. Is it verified from the revenue records the loss of agrarian produce and loss of forest land through these illegal conversions?
- 5. Are the names of such defaulters available and perpetrators ever been penalized and brought to book or only stray cases highlighted?
- ❖ 5 YEAR PLANS AND BACKWARD REGIONS The haphazard planning during the pancvarshik programs and the yearly carnival of budget sessions played to the tune of power brokers and industrialist lobbies have wrecked untold misery upon the common man. The sufferings of the project affected families from the Sardar Sarovar Dam and other areas have not been addressed, their compensation a distant dream but their plight and cause have only drawn a sigh. The fate of the common man had been more comfortable and living conditions more affordable during the British era. The same is chronicled by the media and is underlined by our very Prime Minister, Hon'ble Shri.Manmohan Singh.

The regions close to the earlier pre-independence commercial and trade centres

have developed due to efforts of local entrepreneurs and local capitalists. The other regions continue to lag behind due to inefficient infrastructure and lack of roads, railways, telecommunications, water and electric supply. Basic educational facilities and technical centres are not provided over the past 60 years of independence. These regions churn out the best of corrupt and insensitive politicians whose entire tenure and interest is to support the ruling governments and coterie of politicians at centre and state level. These regions are basically THE BACKWARD REGIONS kept so by the politicians for their own benefit.

❖ RAIGAD AND ALIBAG ANTI-COLONIZATION PLAN - The government should cancel all permissions for industrial projects and townships along the coastal streches of Alibag and render the area as an ECO SENSITIVE ZONE.

So what should be the alternative and in which direction should DEVELOPMENT head?

- All industrial melas and so called SEZs and Townships in excess of 100 Acres already approved and/or proposed in Raigad, Pune and Thane should be made to compulsory shift to BACKWARD REGIONS and DISTRICTS of Dhule, Nandurbar, Sindhudurg, Beed, Parbhani, Osmanabad, Yavatmal, Gondia, Gadchiroli, Chandrapur and Bhandardara, where there is an urgent need for development of local economy.
- The so called SEZ entrepreneurs may be given sops in the land acquisition process, and other benefits if they shift to the backward regions of above districts.
- The above SEZ destinations would be meaningful and would avoid translocation of employment seekers to already congested towns and mega cities.
- 4. Local populace would welcome these investments in the region and as the same would give them a chance to alleviate their poverty and move up in life
- 5. Newer and better infrastructure will be created to benefit the local people.
- 6. Referendum should be taken among land owners in the entire district where the project is located and not only affected villagers area to seek

- their approval before proceeding further.
- 7. Acquisition of land where large parcels of government or municipal land in excess of 1 acre is to be acquired should be advertised in local and national dailies (among 2 Nos. largest circulating newspapers) and an open bid/offer be invited from parties and general public for purchase of such land so that the state/government is not a looser in terms of monetary compensation.
