Floods have inundated hundreds of villages in Bihar and affected millions of people. The flooding is a result of severe overflowing of river Kosi on the Nepal-India border. The worst hit districts are Supaul, Araria, Madhepura, Saharsa, Purnea and Katihar. The floods have been declared a national catastrophe by the India Prime Minister.

Flood victims are struggling to get access to food, water, shelter and hygiene kits. Pregnant and lactating mothers are not getting safe water and are forced to defecate in flood waters. The need for hygiene and sanitation is crucial to prevent the spread of water-borne diseases.

Oxfam and its local partner organizations have been rescuing people and responding to the crisis since 18 August 2008, when flood waters destroyed several districts. Oxfam is scaling up its response on temporary shelter, food, water and sanitation.

2.7 million people affected. 700,000 displaced in one district lone. 250,000 houses washed away.

## Oxfam India's Plan of Action

 To begin with Oxfam is reaching out to 20, 000 families in Supaul, one of the worst affected districts.

Oxfam is using -

- Motorboats to rescue stranded men, women and children from Supaul
- Tarpaulin shelter sheets for temporary shelter
- Water purification kits, buckets to store clean water and Oral Rehydration Sachets (ORS)

Oxfam is rendering around the clock support to the people affected by flood.
